



Capital City Comic Con – Cosplay Contest

Rules and Regulations

- ALL costumes must adhere to our Code of Conduct and Weapons Policy.
- ALL contestants must have purchased either a Sunday Pass or a 3 Day Pass to the Capital City Comic Con.
- Contestants that have not signed up will not be eligible to compete in the contest.
- All costumes must be at least 50% created and not rented or store purchased.
- Adults will select their level of Novice, Journeyman, Master or Closet Cosplay.
- Adults may not compete in Kid's contest but may walk on and assist with a child's presentation.
- Kids 12 & under can enter the Cosplay Contest at the convention on Sunday. The time and place are to be determined.
- Judging will be based on creativity, time involved, overall design and stage presentation.
- Pre-judging will analyze the costume's materials, creation process, craftsmanship and cosplayer's details.
- ALL cosplay MUST be family friendly. No crude behaviors, illegal activities, running, climbing, or being offensive.
- Judges reserve the right to exclude any costume from the show that he/she deems inappropriate or for any reason they determine to be sufficient.
- Only enter the stage and exit the stage at the designated entry/exit points.
- There will be first, second and third place winners in each category – kids and adults.
- Prizes will be given out after the contest and pictures will be taken. An adult must be there to sign for the children's prizes.
- All contestants MUST appear and line up 30 minutes BEFORE the start of the contest. Any contestant missing during the lineup/pre-contest setup time will be forfeited from the contest.
- Large elaborate costumes must be handled by the contestant and/or assistants the contestant brings to help.
- No projectiles, glitter, ooze, wet paint, pyrotechnics, etc. The stage must remain in the same condition it started.
- Judges decisions are final.
- By submitting your application, you agree to abide by the contest rules and regulations.
